

Council Chambers.

Township Falls, Oct. 10, 1903

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 10 o'clock for the transaction of the general business of the Township.

All the members present. The Rime in the chair.

Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.

A Report from the Local Board of Health was presented recommending that this Council pay Mr M. Trulland \$20⁰⁰ for waiting on a patient quarantined at the home of Mr J. A. Trulland. The Board also recommended that this Council engage the services of three competent persons to attend all families ^{quarantined} in this Township each person to receive \$10⁰⁰ per day for each family under his care during the time they are quarantined.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw to provide for the payment of moneys.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Kelly that Bylaw No 223 to provide for the payment of moneys be now introduced and read a first time.

Carried

The Bylaw was read a first time.

On motion of Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Kelly Council now adjourned till 11 o'clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council again resumed present as before.

be instructed as follows:

- 1st. To give out job of building Bridge and putting washout at Wm McLoughlin
- 2nd To examine Bridge at Duncan McLarin and if necessary have same repaired.
- 3rd To examine culvert at August Greis and make an estimate of the cost of putting same in repair

Moved by Mr Butner seconded by Mr Black that Messrs Bennett & Curry be appointed a deputation from the Council to wait on the Cobden session at their next meeting with a view to effecting a settlement re. the Town Hall. Carried

Mr Black gives notice that he will at this present session of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of authorizing the Town to appoint an arbitrator to act re the valuation of the Town Hall at Cobden provided a settlement with the Village of Cobden is not otherwise effected.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Butner that Bylaw No. 224 for the purpose aforesaid be now introduced and read a first time. Carried
