

Council Chambers

Forester's Falls. Dec. 5: 1903

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 10 o'clock for ^{trans-action of the} general business of the Township.

Present - all the members, the reverend in the Chair.

Minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

Notices of their intention to introduce Bylaws at present meeting of Council were given as follows -

First - To provide for the payment of salaries and accounts by Mr Butner.

Second - To provide a polling booth for Polling Sub. division No. 1. by Mr Butner.

Third - To Appoint Deputy Returning Officers for the three Polling Sub-divisions of the Township of Ross by Mr Daly.

A Bill for \$50.00 from Mr C B Miner for putting up pipes in Hall at Cobden was presented for payment. The Council considered - as they no longer required the said Hall for meetings they were not entitled to pay the said amount.

The Clerk was instructed to notify Mr Miner to this effect.

Moved by Mr Bunnick seconded by Mr Black that Bylaw No 225 to provide for the payment of salaries & accounts - be now introduced and read a first time.

second to give out job of building

culvert on road at H. J. McMillips
Third To have fence at Mr Shannon removed off road allowance provided the said Mr Shannon fails to have the same done within the time specified above
