3rd - From the Good Roads Machinery Co. setting forth the merits of their machinery.

The Committee appointed at last meeting of Council to keep the Cobden Road in repair, reported that as advised by the Council, they had tried the Road Grasper on the said road, and found it to work satisfactorily. as a snow-plough they had engaged Mr. Robt. Bulmer to plough the road after snow storms and would recommend that he be paid for his services.
