Forster's Falls. April 2. 1904

The Municipal Council of the Township of Rosa
Assembled this forenoon at 11 O'clock for
the transaction of the general business of
the Township.

All the members present except Mr
Hoffman, the Reve in the Chair.

The Minutes of last meeting were
accepted as read confirmed and signed
by the Reve.

A communication from the Reve of
Cobden was read in which he stated that
he was appointed ^{by the Village Council} to settle the matter
regarding the Town Hall, with this Council
and that any time we desire it he would
be pleased to meet with us with a view
to effecting a satisfactory settlement.

Mr John Jeffery appeared before the Council
asking that till be furnished for two
cubits on the Down line Rosa & Bromley.

The Auditors Report was presented
and examined and the motion

of Mr Haly seconded by Mr Bulmer was accepted.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Haly that the following changes be made in township officers for present year viz: John Chas, William Collins, and John Burnett Pastmaster in place of Allen Gilmore, W. H. Collins and Robt Williams respectively, - and George Ross. Round-Rip in place of Tho. Appleby. Carried.

On motion of Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Ross Council adjourned to meet again at 1 O'clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council again resumed. All the members present.

Messrs Jas Burton and Herman Holschmidt ^{approached to} waited on the Council asking for repairs on four bridges on proof line between lots 10 and 11 Con. 2.

It was agreed by the Council that the Road Com. be empowered to expend a sum on this road not exceeding forty dollars.

James Logan Sr was granted \$2⁰⁰ for breaking snow Road.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Ross that ^{Council} this grant \$15⁰⁰ to the Public Library Carried.

Moved by Mr Haly seconded by Mr Bulmer that the Clerk certify R. C. Power Sanitary Inspector. so far that the dumping house on Goulds Line be kept in a sanitary condition. Carried.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Bulmer that Wm Murdock be engaged as Road Commissioner at a salary of \$35⁰⁰ and Road Machine Operator at \$75⁰⁰ per day.
Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Hoffman that the Road com. examine Town Line between Ross and Westmeath west of Muskrat Lake and report at next meeting of council
Carried.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Hany that Robt Bulmer be granted 16 cts per Rod towards building wire fence on West side of prop Line between lots no 10 & 11. Cong. from Government Road to top of Hill.
Carried.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw to prohibit persons from having horses or vehicles on the sidewalks in this village.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Ross that Bylaw no 230 for the purpose aforesaid be now introduced, and read a first time.
Carried.

The Bylaw was introduced and read a first time.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Hoffman that the Revere be appointed a representative of this Council to meet and confer with Mr Hlatky regarding settlement of Town Hall at Coburn.
Carried.
