

Council Chamber
Foster's Hall, June 25, 1906

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at ten o'clock for the transaction of the general business of the township. All the Members present. The Reverend the Chair.

Minutes of last meeting were read. In the motion granting Mr Robt Bulmer \$15⁰⁰ towards building and keeping in repair a certain culvert, a clause was inserted to the effect that he keep said culvert in repair only so long as he uses same as a cattle pass.

The minutes were then confirmed and signed by the Rev.

Communications from J. L. Morris (C.S.) re survey of Colman Road, and P. White agreeing to accept \$20⁰⁰ in full of Mr. Maclean's account against this township were read.

A petition from Thos Barrie was presented asking that this Council open up a portion of the 8th Con. line opposite the S² of Lot No 4, as he required this road as a means of travel to and from his Lot. Mr Barrie also asked permission to perform his statute labor on said 8th con. line, which request was granted.

A New Road Division was formed on the 8th Con Line beginning at the dividing line between the N¹/₂ and the S¹/₂ of Lot No 4 and continuing to the dividing line between Lots No. 5 & 6. The persons required to perform statute labor on

this division being Thos Baites, Thos
Mathison, Robt Mathison and W R Kirk.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr
Bulmer that the Assessor be paid
\$4⁰⁰ for services equalizing Union School
Ross & Bromley and Ross & Cobden.
Carried.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Bulmer
that Norman Byce be granted the
eleventh Concession line ^{opposite Lot No 12.} to the full width
in view of another road opened through
said Lot No 12; that an agreement to that
effect be drawn up and signed by the
Recorder and Clerk and that the seal of
the Corporation be attached to same.
Carried.

Mr John Thrasher presented a petition
re. forced road from Curry & Thrasher's saw
mill to Jno Robinson's

Mr Jno Campbell requested the Council
to furnish material sufficient for a
siding for bridge over gully on road
near his lot.

Mr Campbell was instructed to
procure the necessary material for which
the Council would pay 1¢ per ft.

On motion of Mr Bulmer seconded by
Mr Haly Council adjourned till the
next.

Council again resumed pursuant
as before.

John Campbell and James Sutcliffe
appeared before the Council
asking that they have the concession

line opposite their lots surveyed.
No action was taken in the matter.
A petition from Daniel
Reynolds, was read, asking to have
the Proof Line from No 2 school House
to Prior Line Ross & Bromley opened
for public travel. As this portion
of Road had in 1868 been given in
line of another road opened up,
the Council considered it inadvis-
able to deal with the matter.

Re. Road from Sawmill to Jno
Robinson the clerk was instructed
to find out whether this road was
ever established as a public highway.

Moved by Mr Haley seconded by
Mr Bulmer that Charles Power be
granted \$12.⁰⁰ for digging ditch on
4th con line work to be ~~performed~~
by Road Commissioner Carried
A Bill from Thos McHay for \$2.05-
for cedar for culvert and umboning spring
on road was presented and passed.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by
Mr Haley that the Road Commissioner
be authorized to expend a sum of
money not exceeding \$20.⁰⁰ on the
Pembroke road West of Cobden
Carried

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr
Ross that the Road Commissioner be
instructed as follows: -

- to examine and estimate cost of up
grading Road on 8th con. line near The Bako,
- (2) Cobden Road from Brick yard corner to

Mill Creek (3) sixth con. line from lot 11
 to lot 15. 5 To inspect bridge built
 by J Campbell. 6. To inspect bridge on
 Cobden Road at Tho Ross. 7. To hire teams
 if possible and grade Cobden Road from
 Duffys Mill to Gibson's Corner.
