

Council Chambers
Parsons Falls July 30, 19

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at ten o'clock for the transaction of the general business of the Township. All the members present, the Reeve in the chair.

Minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

A communication from the Reeve of Cobden to the Reeve of Ross, offering to settle the Down Hall question for \$415⁰⁰ was read.

Mr Curry informed the council that he had written Mr Delahay accept the said amount.

The following persons appeared before the council Board viz.

Mr Jno Gardiner as a representative of the Ross and Bromley Agricultural Society asking aid.

Messrs Duncan McLaren and Wm Cady to learn what action this council intends taking re. the disputed corner at rear end of their lots.

Mr Wm Cady in behalf of the Orange Lodge asking this council to sell to them about 1/2 of land off the lower end of the property on which the Down Hall is built.

Mr Hoffman drew the attention of the council to the dangerous condition of Bridge on road near Jas Logan's.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Dalry that a grant of \$15⁰⁰ be given to the Ross & Bromley Agricultural Society.

Carried

On motion of Mr Haly recorded by Mr
Ross Council adjourned till 1. O'clock
Pursuant to adjournment Council
again resumed present as before.

The Road Commissioner reported on
the condition of Bridge on Cobden Road
at Thos Ross's, Bridge near Morrow's
gate, Road leading to Thos Bairds
and road at Thos Matheson's

Messrs S Murdoch and H Pettinger
appeared before the Council asking for
a wider road into their places.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr
Hoffman that the Clerk be author-
ized to procure 1000 ft of planks delivered
on the ground for repairing of bridge
over Mill Pond at Foust's Dale.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by
Mr Haly that Messrs Curry and Ross
be appointed to interview Mr Duffy
with a view of obtaining through him
aid from the County Council towards
repairing said bridge at Foust's Dale.

Carried.

Mr Andrew Rastwell appeared asking
that this Council would cause the
proof line between Lots 10 & 16, from
Downline Ross and Bromley to School
House No. 2, to be opened up for travel.

The Council after considering the
matter decided to take no action.

Mr Jno Brown as a representative
of the N. R. A. S. appeared before the
Board soliciting aid for that
society.

Moved by Mr Haly seconded by Mr

Bulmer that the N.R.A.S. be given
a grant of \$1000. Carried.

Mr Thos Gibson asked aid from the
Council towards building a wire fence
on his property where snow blocks
road.

The Council decided to take no action
at present in the matter.

The Road Commissioner was
instructed as follows: - viz. -

1. Examine: 1st. Two Bridges and one
culvert at Muncan McLarnt and report
at next meeting
2. Bridge at Jas Logans and give out job
on same.
3. Reckon from line opposite W.J. Pelligano's
and report at next meeting
4. Road into Thos Gibson's
5. Bridge at foot of Tuffis Hill and have
same repaired.
6. Give out job of repairing Bridge near
Monnow's gate.
7. To Carry out instructions issued at
a former meeting of Council re. repairs
of Cobden Road.

Moved by Mr Daly seconded by Mr Ros
