Goussier's Falls Oct 8, 1900

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled at this forenoon at 10 O'Clock for the transaction of the general business of the Township.

All the members present, the were in the Chair

Minutes of last meeting of Council were accepted as read, and confirmed.

Communications were read from Edward Duffy County Councillor re. Goussier's Falls Bridge, and J. L. Morris C.L.S. re. road leading from Government Road to Grant's Settlement.

Obadiak Edmunds and John Seobit raised on the Council ^{oppositions to} the proposed transferring of Concession line to owners of Lots No. 25 and 26 in the 3rd Concession.

On motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr. Bulmer Council adjourned till One O'Clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council again resumed present as before.

A petition from Frederick Foss signed by a number of Rate payers was read, praying that this Council would not open up proof line between Lots No. 15 and 16 in the first Concession.

The Commission appointed at last meeting of Council to examine this proving line, reported that in their opinion no action could be taken at

present in the matter.

A Communication from P. White to E. Puffy re. Forsters Falls Bridge was presented and read.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Bulmer that the Revue and Mr Ross be appointed to interview the County Council at its next session re. obtaining aid towards the building of Bridge at Forsters Falls.

The Road Commissioner submitted his report to the Council. Messrs Munce and Alex Mc Laren drew the attention of the Council to two Culverts on road near their places which were in need of repair.

The Clerk was instructed to notify James Logan, Kaeup Station, to have bridge built immediately as per contract; also James Rankin to have Bridge at James Luvall's repaired, and Wm McWade to have hole in road on his division filled.

The Road Commissioner was instructed as follows.

1. To examine drain at Longall Pavers.
2. To have bridge at Wm Lees's repaired.
3. To have hole on Cobden road near Watson's corner filled.
4. To have Puffy's Hill repaired and
5. To interview John Crozier re. muzzing road around hill opposite his place. Cost of road not to exceed \$10.⁰⁰
