

Council Chambers,

Forster's Falls, N.B. Dec. 10, 1904

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 11 O'Clock for the transaction of the general business of the Township.

Present: All the members, the Reeve in the Chair.

Minutes of last meeting of Council were accepted, as read and confirmed.

A communication from F. Perry was read, stating that he had succeeded in obtaining assistance from the C.P.R. Co towards building approaches to Railway track on Downtime Ross and Westmeash.

John Cowley appeared before the Council asking to have the fences on road passing his place moved to their proper places.

This request was granted, and the clerk was instructed to notify the owners of said fences to remove same as above stated.

On Motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr Hoffman Council adjourned till One O'Clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council resumed present as before.

Messrs Perry and Ross reported that they had succeeded in obtaining a grant of \$400. from the County Council towards building the Forster's Falls Bridge.

Mr John Thrasher appeared asking what action this Council had taken in regard to road to Grants Settlement.

Mr Haley gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law for the purpose of appointing Deputy Returning Officers for the three polling sub-divisions of the Township of Ross.

Mr Hoffman gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law to transfer that portion of allowance for road situate and lying between the third and fourth Concessions opposite Lots No 25 and 26 in the Township of Ross and to convey the same by deed to the owners of Lots No. 25 and 26 in the third Concession.

That Order was granted \$10<sup>00</sup> for work on Road.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Haley that Messrs Butner and Ross be appointed a committee to look after the Rossers Falls Bridge.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Butner seconded by Mr Hoffman that Bylaw No. 232 for the appointment of Deputy Returning Officers be now introduced and read a first time.

Carried.

The Bylaw was introduced and read a first time.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by  
Mr Ross that Bylaw No 233 for the  
purpose of transferring the allowance  
for road between the third and fourth  
Concessions opposite Lots No 25 and 26.  
as aforesaid be now introduced  
and read a first time.

Carried.

The Bylaw was introduced and  
read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Daly seconded by Mr  
Bulmer the clerk was instructed to  
notify <sup>st</sup> the owners of fences along road  
leading to the Grants Ridge to have  
said fences removed off road allowance  
where said road is fenced to a width  
of less than forty (40) feet <sup>3<sup>rd</sup></sup> - also to  
notify Harry Beaton to remove stumps  
off Road allowance and 3<sup>rd</sup> to write  
John Campbell to deliver at Forster's  
Falls Bridge. The Clerk left over from  
building Bridge near his place.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr  
Daly that Mr Ross be paid \$3<sup>00</sup>  
for drive and expenses - attending the  
County Council re obtaining aid  
towards building of Forster's Falls  
Bridge

Carried.

On motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr  
Daly Bylaw No 232 was filed in with  
the names of W. R. Kirk for poll. sub. div.  
No 1. P. R. Pender for polling sub. div.  
No 2. and John Jardine for polling sub. div.  
No 3. and then brought up and  
read a second and third time short and  
passed.

On Motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr Daly Bylaw No. 233 was brought up and read a second - and third time short and Passed.
