

Council Chambers  
Forster's Falls April 1st 1905

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 10.30 o'clock for the transaction of the general business of the township.

All the members were present, the warden in the chair.

Minutes of last regular meeting and a special session were accepted as read and confirmed.

The following communications were read. From the Institution for the Blind & Dumb, Belleville; from the National Sanatorium Association; a petition from the Clerk of the County of Elgin re. the amending of the act with reference to Municipalities liability for keeping roads in repair; from J. L. Morris re. C.P.R. land in the township; from A. W. Campbell re. appropriation of money for road purposes.

James McWade appeared before the council in regard to a road taken off his lot.

James and David Brown appeared before the council re. the concession line past their place.

On motion of Mr Black seconded by Mr Haly council adjourned till One o'clock. Council again resumed present as before.

Mr Ross gives notice that he will at this present meeting of council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of transferring the allowance for road between the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> & the S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of lot No 9 in the 8th con. from the Government Road eastward to the 9th con. line and conveying the



same by deed to the owner of the 8<sup>th</sup> of lot No 9 in the said 8<sup>th</sup> concession another means of travel having been acquired.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Hoffman that by law No 236 for the purpose aforesaid be now introduced and read a first time. Carried  
The by law was introduced, and read a first time.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Hoffman that the following standard of assessment be taken in making out the statute labor lists - and that all preceding standards be repealed,

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Walby that the Road Commissioner be instructed to examine the following places. 1st The Bridge on road at Wm McLaughlin's 2. Bridge on road at Wm Elliott's - and 3. Road opposite Chas J. Rivers, and to have these places repaired if necessary



On Motion of Mr Black seconded by Mr Hoffman, Mr Haly was instructed to purchase three Road Scrapers.

On Motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr Haly Bylaw no 236 was read a second and third time short and passed.
