

Council Chambers, Forster's Falls

May, 11th, 1905

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this day for the purpose of drafting Plans and Specifications for the rebuilding of the Forster's Falls Bridge and the repairing of the Cross Lane on the Cobden road at head of Muskrat Lake.

All the members were present, the Reeve in the Chair.

On motion of Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Daly, Mr F. J. Moxam was appointed to inspect the work to be done on the Forster's Falls Bridge.

Moved by Mr Daly seconded by Mr Hoffman that tenders for the rebuilding of the said bridge and also the delivering of 100 Cords of stone to be laid on the ^{road} Cross Lane on the Cobden Road, be advertised for in the "Cobden Sun" Carried.

Moved by Mr Daly seconded by Mr Black that the tenders be opened on the 3rd day of June, and that the lowest or any tender be not necessarily accepted. Carried.

The Council then adjourned.
