

Council Chambers

Trustee Falls, Aug. 5, 1905

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this day at 10 o'clock A.M. for the transaction of general business, with the Reeve and Messrs Black and Ross present, the reeve in the chair.

On motion of Mr Black seconded by Mr Ross minutes of last meeting were accepted as read and confirmed.

The following communications were read: - From W. C. Brink, tendering for the purchase of debtors from Edward Duffy Esq re Miss Annie Mulligan and from Thos Gorman re of Bromley re. a certain ditch on town line.

On motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr Black Council adjourned to meet at one o'clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council again assembled with all the members present.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Haly that in regard to Miss Annie Mulligan the case be left in the hands of the reeve to deal with

The clerk was instructed to inform the Reeve of Bromley that this Council is willing to bear half the expense of deepening a ditch on town line between Ross & Bromley, mentioned in his communication

Mr W. J. Rustigun, ^{appeared} before the Council asking for a grant of money to be expended on the ~~road~~ line between Ross and Westmeath opposite Lot No. 6. on first concession East of Mustkrat Lake.

Moved by Mr Healy seconded by Mr Black that this Council grant the sum of 25⁰⁰ to be expended on this road provided Westmeath Council will spend the same. Carried.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Healy that Messrs Ross & F. J. Moyam be appointed to prepare plans and specifications for the rebuilding of the Foustier's Falls Bridge and have same ready for the next meeting of Council. Carried.
