

Council Chambers, Forster's Hall
September 7, 1905

Pursuant to adjournment on August 5th the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 10 o'clock for general business with all the members present. The Rev. in the Chair. The minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

The following communications were read by: - From Mr W. C. Bunt re. the purchase of debentures. D. W. Mc Garry Esq. re. Miss Annie Mulligan on Joseph Allan Esq. Portage-du-Fort re. road to Dalry's. On motion of Mr Dalry seconded by seconded by Mr Ross Council adjourned till one o'clock.

Council again resumed present as before.

Mr John Jardnie asked for a grant of \$10⁰⁰ in aid of the Ross & Bromley Agricultural Society.

Mr Fred Ross appeared before the Council re. condition of bridge near his farm.

Mr Dalry gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a by law for the purpose of levying a rate so much the current expenses of the Township, the County rate the amount required by law under the Public School Act of Ontario for schools and the amounts required by the Statutes of the several school sections.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Dalry that a grant of \$10⁰⁰ be given the R. & B. A. S. provided Cobden and Bromley

grant the same. Carried.

Mr Chas Corbett appeared before the Council asking to have a portion of the 3rd Concession Line surveyed.

On motion of Mr Daly seconded by Mr Hoffman by law No 239. re-lyy was given its first reading and on motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr Daly the blanks were filled in as follows: -
Township rate $2\frac{7}{8}$ Mills. County rate $2\frac{1}{2}$ Mills. General School Rate $1\frac{7}{8}$ Mills and the remaining blanks with the rates required by the Trustees of the several School Sections and then read a second and third time short and passed.

Messrs Ross and Moten presented new plans and specifications for the building of the Bridge at Foresters Falls. After the Council had examined and considered the same they were deemed satisfactory, and accepted.

On motion of Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Black the Clerk was instructed to advertise for tenders in the Colden Sun said tenders to be opened on October 20th. Plans and specifications to be left at the Clerks office for inspection.

A petition signed by a number of rate-payers asking for a survey of the 4th Concession line opposite lots 23, 20 and 26. was laid on the table.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Black that all persons owning

and adjoining the road leading to
the Grants settlement he requested to
meet the Council at their next session
Carried.
