The Road Commissioner reported verbally on the condition of Roads & Bridges under his supervision.

c - a committee to examine with the Road Commissioner, the bridge at Duncan McFarren's.

The communications received since the last meeting of Council were read.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Ross that we adjourn till one o'clock carried.

Council again resumed. present as before.

A petition from a number of ratepayers asking to have the line between the first and second concessions East of Muskrat Lake located, was laid on the table.

Moved by Mr Ross seconded by Mr Halcy that a surveyor be brought in to locate the following lines. 1st The line between the first and second concession East of Muskrat Lake from the town line Ross and Westmark to the Collier road. 2nd The line between the second and third



Concession from lot 11 to lot 15 both lots inclusive and 3rd the line between the third and fourth concessions from lot 1 to the Downline Ross & Gordon.

Carried.

A number of ratepayers from the Grants Ridge appeared before the council regarding the widening of road into said Ridge as requested at last meeting of Council. A satisfactory arrangement was arrived at by agreement with all the parties present. They agreeing to widen the road through their respective lots to a width of forty feet the council to give them the original allowance for road in lieu thereof.

On Motion of Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Dalry Messrs Ross and Black were appointed to wait on Mr Robt. Bulmer re said road through his lot.

The tenders for the Building of Forsters Falls bridge were opened, and were as follows:-

From Mr Peter Wilson who tendered for the job at \$2650. with water in dam let off and \$2800 with water on. and from Mr Edgar Caswell at \$1850. with water off and \$1950. with water on up to bottom of waste gate.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Ross that Mr Caswell's tender be accepted namely \$1950. with water off. <sup>portion</sup> ~~to top~~ of waste gate.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Hoffman seconded by Mr Dalry that Mr F J Mottram be appointed to inspect bridge and to receive for same \$37<sup>50</sup> and \$250 for assisting in drawing up Plans and Specifications.

Carried



Mr Gady appeared before the council regarding a certain drain through his and other lots in the Village.

No action was taken by the council.
