

Foresters Falls May 15th 1906

A special meeting of the Council of the Township of Ross was held here this 15th of May at 1 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of making arrangements for the repairing of certain Roads and Bridges that were in a bad condition. All the members of the Council except Mr. Haley were present, the Reeve in the chair.

It was moved by Mr. McSellar and seconded by Mr. McBlug that the Road Commissioner be instructed to have the following roads, culverts &c repaired and to give out jobs for the same:

Tuffy's Hill, ^{Grass Hill} Culvert at McEwen's, Culvert at Thos. Ross; Coffey's Bridge on the Foresters Falls-Cobden Road, and the Road near James Suttcliffe's. Carried.

On motion of Mr. McBlug seconded by Mr. Elliott the Road Commissioner was instructed to meet ~~Mr.~~ W. C. Eady the Road Commissioner of Horton, on the Town Line between Ross and Horton on a date to be mutually agreed upon, to arrange for the repairing of said road.

On motion of Mr. McBlug, seconded by Mr. McSellar the Clerk was instructed to notify Thos. McKay, the Pathmaster in Grants Settlement to have the culvert in road opposite John Jamieson's round ^{immediately} repaired.

Moved by Mr. McSellar seconded by Mr. Elliott that Lorenzo Edmunds be allowed to do his statute Labor for the current year on the road opposite his own house. Carried.

On motion of Mr. McBlug seconded by Mr. Elliott, Edward Neil was appointed Pathmaster instead of James Creeland deceased.

On motion of Mr. McBlug seconded by Mr. McSellar the Council then adjourned.
