Council Chamber Forester Falls July 7 1900
The Municipal Council of the Township of
Ross met here this day at 10 o'clock A. M. for the
Transaction of general business, all the members
being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the last meeting of Council
and also of the Court of Revision having been
read, were on motion of W^m McTellan, seconded
by Robt. Haley, duly adopted.

After the reception of several bills and com-
munications and discussion thereon, it was
moved by Robt Haley and seconded by W^m McTellan
that the sum of \$12⁰⁰ be granted to Richard Q. Peever
for work done on his Road Division in excess
of Statute Labor. Carried

On motion of Mr. Haley, seconded by
Mr. McTellan the Council adjourned for one hour

On re-assembling, it was moved by Mr. McTellan
and seconded by Mr. Elliott that the Road Commissioner
be instructed to examine 6th Concession opposite
Robert Johnston's and to report upon the advisability
of opening up said Concession ^{or as a grade} ~~to the~~
~~road to Samuel Johnston's Jr.~~ Carried

On motion of Mr. McTellan seconded by Mr. Haley
Councillor Elliott was instructed to interview
John C. Crozier with a view to purchasing
from him land for a road around rock opposite
his lot if such purchase can be made on reasonable terms.

It was moved by W^m McTellan and seconded
by H. McTellan that all parties be forbidden to remove
any part of the side-walk in Forester Falls in the
future and that the clerk be instructed to notify
those who may have already made such open-
ings to have them properly closed up immediately
legal proceedings to be taken against them should
they neglect or refuse to do so. Carried

Foresters Falls Aug 4th 1906
The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met here this day at 10 o'clock A.M. for the transaction of general business. All the members were present. The Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting of Council having been read, were on motion of Robt. Healy, seconded by W^m McLellan duly adopted.

A number of bills and accounts were then read by the clerk and considered and discussed by the Council.

On motion of H. McLurg, seconded by Robt. Healy the Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling at 1 o'clock, it was moved by Mr. Healy, seconded by Mr. Elliott that the Road Commissioner be instructed to give out a job of ditching on the 1st Concession opposite Joseph Walker said ditch to extend from Mrs. Jas. Peever's gate westward to creek and not to cost more than \$20⁰⁰. Carried.

On motion of Robt. Healy, seconded by W^m McLellan a grant of \$10⁰⁰ was made to Ross + Bromley A. Society.

On motion of W^m McLellan, seconded by Mr. Healy the clerk was instructed to request W^m Muddock to have the Foresters Falls - Cobden Road graded at all necessary places from the 5th Concession to the corner near School House of Section No. 1. Also from culvert
