

Council Chambers Foresters Falls Sept 29

The regular Meeting of Ross Council was held here this day. The Reeve being absent, Mr. Haley took the chair.

The Minutes of last meeting of Council having been read were duly adopted.

On motion of Mr. Elliott, seconded by Mr. McElung the Reeve and J. H. McElliott were appointed to interview Robt. Johnston, Sr. with a view to purchasing land around a rock-hill so as to secure a road for Samuel Johnston Jr.

Mr. Elliott then gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of levying rates to pay the ordinary expenses of the Township; the County rate; The Township Sabenture; the amt. reqd to be levied on the Township for School purposes by the Public Schools act of 1906 and the local school levies as per the requisition of the Trustees of the several sections. On motion of Mr. McElliott, seconded by Mr. McElung the Council then adjourned for one hour. On re-assembling at 1 o'clock, the Reeve being present took the Chair.

On motion of Mr. Haley, seconded by Mr. McElung, By-Law No 246 for the purpose of levying the rates above mentioned was introduced and read a first time.

Moved by Mr. Haley, seconded by J. H. McElliott that J. H. McElung be instructed to have that portion of ditch in Foresters Falls allotted to the Council by the engineer's award duly constructed by Nov 1st next done.

On motion of Mr. McElliott, seconded by Mr. Elliott By-Law No 246 was read a second and third time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Haley, seconded by Mr. McElung the Clerk was instructed to send bill of Statute labor performed by Township of Ross on Town line between Ross and Westmeath to Westmeath Council requesting said Council to pay to the Twp of Ross one dollar for

each day's labors so performed.

It was moved by Mr. Haley, seconded by Mr. Elliott that the clerk be instructed to notify John Ferguson, John Appleby, Geo. Ferguson and Robert Matheson to make a ditch through their land so as to allow the water to run from 5th Concession said water-way to be opened by Nov 10th next. Carried.

On motion of Mr. McCellan, seconded by Mr. Melny the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment of the same

On motion of Mr. Haley seconded by Mr. Elliott the Road Commissioner was instructed to have repairs made on the roads at the following places:

Two Culverts opposite Appleby's, Tuffey's Hill, Culvert at head of Muskrat Lake, Bridge at Wth Elliotts, Bridge at creek near Jamieson's Lime Kiln, Bridge on Proving Line opposite A. Thrasher's

Moved by Mr. Melny seconded by Mr. Elliott that the clerk instruct Jas. Jack to have culvert repaired or a new one put in on Govt. Road opposite J. R. Black. Carried

Moved by Mr. McCellan seconded by Mr. Haley that the motion with reference to the appointment of an enforcer of By-Laws and orders of the Council passed at last meeting of Council be rescinded and that the clerk be instructed to have notices put up in Gravel Pit on Govt. Road near Foresters Falls forbidding all parties to dig holes therein on pain of prosecution. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McLurg, seconded by Mr. Elliott, that John C. Crozier be paid the sum of thirty dollars for land for road around rock opposite his Lot as soon as said land is properly conveyed to the Corporation of Pgs. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. McCellan, seconded by Mr. McLurg, the Council adjourned to meet again on Oct 27th at 10 o'clock A. M.

On reassembling, it was moved by Mr. McLurg and seconded by Mr. McCellan that the Road Commissioner be instructed to give out a job at not more than \$25⁰⁰ on the 4th Concession E. M. L. at or near creek crossing said Concession. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Haley, seconded by Mr. McCellan that Richd. Freeland be allowed to perform his Statute Labor on the 8th Concession between Proving Line and Lot No. 8. Carried.

On motion of Mr. McCellan seconded by Mr. Haley the Reeve was authorized to interview Mr. Robt. Ritchie with a view to purchasing from him a road way round rock on 7th Concession opposite the N 1/2 of Lot No. 3.
