

Foresters Falls Feby 2<sup>nd</sup> 1907

The regular meeting of Council was held here this day at 10 o'clock A.M. all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read, approved of and adopted. A petition was received from the great majority of the ratepayers of the Village of Foresters Falls praying the Council to set apart the Village for Statute Labor purposes and to commute the Statute Labor therein at One Dollar per day. After the reception of several bills and accounts the following Municipal Officers for the current year were appointed and their names entered in the By-Law for the appointment of Municipal Officers for the year 1907

On motion of Mr. Elliott, seconded by Mr. McEwan  
the Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling at 10 o'clock it was moved  
by Mr. Elliott and seconded by Mr. Oates that  
Robt. Elliott and Richd Wall be transferred  
from Geo. Haley's Statute Labor Division to Saml  
McMullen's Division and that the latter Division  
extend to the North-East corner of Robt. Elliott's Lot  
instead of to the North-West corner as at present  
and that W<sup>m</sup> R. Kirk, Mrs. J. C. Patterson, H. J. Moxam  
and John Herron be attached to Robt. Bulmer's Division. Carried.

Mr. McEldau gave notice that he would at this  
meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to provide,  
by the issue of debentures for a loan of \$1150 for which  
the Trustees of School Section Number Twelve in the  
Township of Ross, requisitioned the Council to purchase  
a school-site and to erect a school building in said section.  
Mr. Oates gave notice that he would at this meeting  
of Council introduce a By-Law to provide by the  
issue of debentures for a loan of \$1000. for which  
the Trustees of School Section Number Thirteen in the  
Township of Ross requisitioned the Council to purchase  
a school-site and to erect a school building in said section.  
The Council declined to take any action on the request of either of the above  
School Sections. Ross property to be transferred to S. & No. 12 on the ground that they ha  
no power to alter the award establishing and defining the boundaries of S. & No. 12

On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Elliott the Council agreed to refund the sum of \$3.88 to F. J. Mozam being the amt of taxes paid on Holmes Movement Camp Ground - such land being in the opinion of the Council legally exempt from taxation.

By-Law No. 250 for the purpose of providing for a loan of \$1150 for School Section No. Twelve was then introduced, and on motion of Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. McEellan read a first time.

By-Law No 251 for the purpose of providing for a loan of \$1000 for School Section No Thirteen was then introduced and on motion of Mr. McEellan seconded by Mr. Cates read a first time.

Mr. McEwan then gave notice that he would at the next regular meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of commuting the Statute Labor in the Village of Foresters Falls and for defining the limits of said Village.

Mr. H. McSug then waited on the Council and explained that the Council of 1896 had promised a grant of \$50. towards the construction of a side walk in Foresters Falls on condition that the people of said Village and its vicinity contributed an equal amount. He had recd subscriptions amounting to about \$80<sup>00</sup> and wished the Council to contribute dollar for dollar. It was then moved by Mr. Elliott and seconded by Mr. McEwan that \$50 be granted towards the building of such side-walk and that W. S. Coleman, F. J. Mozam and J. J. Elliott be a Committee to oversee the work <sup>carried</sup>

On motion of Mr. Cates seconded by Mr. McEellan the time for the return of the Roll by the Collector was extended until the First day of March next.

On motion of Mr. Elliott, seconded by Mr. Cates By-Law No 250 was read a second and third time short and finally passed. On motion of Mr. McEellan seconded by Mr. McEwan By-Law No 251 was read a second and third time short and finally passed.

Mr. E. G. Coulter appeared before the Council and presented the desirability of opening the line between the 2<sup>nd</sup> Con. and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Con from Proving Line between Lots 10 and 11 eastward to Almstead's Lake. It was then moved by Mr. McEwan, seconded by Mr. Elliott that a new Road Division be formed of Lots 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Concessions with Edward Sammon as Pathmaster, the work in said Road Division to be performed on that part of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Concession lying within said Road Division. Carried
