

Council Chambers F.F. June 29th /07

The regular Meeting of Council was held here this day at 10 o'clock A.M. All the members being present except Mr. Gates, the Reeve in the Chair.

The minutes of the Court of Revision, the last regular Meeting of Council, and the Special meeting of Council having been read were approved of and adopted.

A number of communications, and bills and accounts were received and considered.

On motion of Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. Elliott the Road Commissioner was instructed to examine the Bridge on Irving's line between Lots 10 and 11 in the 7th Con. and report at next meeting of Council.

It was moved by Mr. McEwan and seconded by Mr. Elliott that Peter Wilson be allowed to put in a cattle pass on the forced Road east of Muskrat Lake opposite his Lot, that he be allowed to perform his Statute Labor in Road Division No 23 (E. Burns) instead of in Road Division No. 41 (James Childerhose's) Carried

On motion of Mr. Elliott seconded by Mr. McEwan the Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling at 1 o'clock Mr. Elliott gave notice that at a future regular Meeting of Council he would introduce a By-Law for the purpose of transferring the Road Allowance between Lots Nos 10 and 11 to ^{in the 11th Concession} John Byce. The Road Allowance between the 3rd and the 4th Concessions opposite and adjacent to Lot No 27 to Arthur Humphries and the Road Allowance between the 4th and the 5th Concessions opposite and adjacent to Lots Numbers 23, 24, and 25 to Albert Rafkie, Amos Edmonds and John Scobie.

Mr. McEwan gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to effect a loan to meet the current expenses of the municipality. On motion of Mr. Elliott seconded by Mr. McEwan the Road Commissioner was instructed to have Rocks blasted at the following places. Queen's line near Mrs. Jewell, Opposite Lot No 20 Con 5. and also Rock on road near Charles McIntyre

By-law No 254 for the purpose of raising funds to meet the current expenses of the municipality was then introduced and on motion of Mr. McEellan seconded by Mr. Elliott, read a first-time.

On motion of Robt. Elliott, seconded by Mr. McEellan the clerk was instructed to notify Joseph Bennett and Edward Pettigrew to have the gates removed from Road allowance between the 5th and 6th Concessions opposite their Lots not later than July 6th next.

On motion of Mr. Elliott seconded by Mr. McEellan Joseph Jeffrey was authorized to procure plank at the expense of the municipality to make a foot-path 95 ft long by 20 in. wide across lake opposite his house.

On motion of Mr. McEellan seconded by Mr. Elliott that the clerk ^{was instructed} notify James Brown, John Robinson, John Powers and John Powers to have their fences ^{removed and} placed on the proper boundary lines of the Road allowance between Concessions 8 and 9 adjacent to their Lots, not later than 15th October next.

On motion of Mr. McEellan seconded by Mr. Elliott the ~~black in~~ By-Law No 254 was read a second and third time short and finally passed.

Moved by Mr. Elliott, seconded by Mr. McEellan that provided the necessary fall for the water can be secured, the sum of \$25⁰⁰ be granted to purchase tile for and to raise and widen the street from the Portage du Fort road to Haley's station, the ratepayers interested to contribute at least 50 percent of grant in labour.
