Foresters Falls Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> 1907

A regular meeting of Council was held here  
 this day at 10 o'clock A. M. all the members being  
 present, the Reeve in the Chair. The minutes  
 of last meeting of Council were read and adopted.  
 A number of bills and accounts were presented  
 and considered, after which on motion of Mr. Bates  
 seconded by Mr. McSellar the Council adjourned  
 for one hour. At 10 o'clock the session was resumed.  
 On motion of Mr. McEwan, seconded by Mr. Elliott  
 the Clerk was instructed to notify Robt. Bulmer to make

no more Culvert-tile for the Municipality without further notice from the Council. It was moved by Mr. Mcellan and seconded by Mr. Oates that the privilege granted at last-meeting <sup>of Council</sup> to the owner of the S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Lot 5 Con. 1 & 2. M. L. of making a cattle pass <sup>under</sup> across the Road Allowance through said Lot have attached to it the condition that said Cattle pass shall be built and maintained by the owner of said Lot to the satisfaction of the Road Commissioner. Carried.

On motion of Mr. Mcellan, seconded by Mr. Oates the Clerk was instructed to notify John D. Ferguson, John Appleby, Geo. B. Ferguson, Robt. Mathieson, Mrs. David Gibson, Robt. Reilly Jr. Isaac Corrie, Hugh Gordon Sr. and Thos. O'Halen to meet the Reeve at or near Hugh Gordon's Sr on Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August-1907 at 4 o'clock in the afternoon with a view of arriving at a satisfactory agreement for the construction of a ditch to drain the Road Allowance between Lots 11, 12 and 13 in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Concessions respectively, in accordance with the provisions of the Ditches and Water-Consolid.

It was moved by Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Mcellan that the Road Commissioner be instructed as follows:-

- (1) to have bridge on Proving Line between Lots 10 and 11 in the 7<sup>th</sup> Con. repaired or rebuilt;
- (2) to have bridge on Govt. Road opposite N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Lot 11 repaired;
- (3) to have bridge on Gould's Line across Creek near old mill-site repaired
- (4) to have bridge at Roach's Creek, old Gold Line, repaired
- (5) to have not more than \$20<sup>00</sup> expended in repairing the Proving Line between Lots 10 and 11 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Concession
- (6) to insist upon the owners of Lots 1, 2 and 3 in the 8<sup>th</sup> Concession and Lots 1, 2 and the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 3 in the 9<sup>th</sup> Concession placing their fences on the proper boundary line of the Road allowance between ~~the~~ Concessions
- (7) to examine bridge on Govt. Road near John C. McDarens and report at next meeting
- (8) to examine the Road allowance between Lots 2 & 3 <sup>in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Concessions respectively</sup> and to report <sup>thereon</sup> at next meeting

meeting of Council upon the <sup>utility and</sup> advisability of opening up said Road Allowance.

It was moved by Mr. Oates and seconded by Mr. Elliott that Mrs John McKeddie be permitted to build a fence across Road Allowance between Lots 37 and 38 below where said Road Allowance has been opened up and to keep up said fence until the Council orders its removal.
