

Foresters Falls Dec. 7th 1907

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day at 9 o'clock, A.M. all the members being present, the Reeve in the Chair.

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of Bills and communications were read and considered. The Rev. S. L. Gordon having been heard in behalf of the Public Library at Foresters Falls on motion of Mr. Vates seconded by Mr. McEwan the usual grant of \$15⁰⁰ was made to said Library. On motion of Mr. McLellan, seconded by Mr. Elliott the Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr. Vates gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law for the purpose of appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the Three Polling Sub-Divisions for the Township, for to hold the Municipal Election of 1908. The by-law having been introduced was on motion of Mr. McLellan seconded by Mr. Elliott read a first time.

Mr. Elliott gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law regarding parties, along the Foresters Falls Cobden Road, the Road between the 8th and 9th Concessions opposite Lots 1, 2, and 3, and along such other Roads in the Township as are subject to being blocked by snow-drifts, liable for all expenses the Council may incur in overcoming the difficulties caused by the neglect or refusal of the said parties to remove their fences from said Road Allowances.

On motion of Mr. McEwan, ^{seconded by Mr. Elliott} the Blanks in By-Law No 256 for the appointment of Dep. Ret. Officers and Poll-Clerks to hold the ensuing municipal elections were filled in as follows:-

and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and passed.

Moved by Duncan McEwan, seconded by John Dales that this Council do hereby permit and consent so far as they have the power to do, to allow the Canadian Pacific Railway to lay their track across the highway, as shown on a plan produced by the said Company showing the proposed extension to ballast siding for tail track, and dated at Ottawa the 18th day of November 1907. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Elliott seconded by Mr. McDellan that James Lavallee be provided with cedars to build two culverts on the blind line in the rear of his lots, he to be allowed two days Statute Labor for building each Culvert, upon the completion of which the Council shall refund him his Commutation tax of \$2.77 for the present year. Carried

On motion of Mr. McDellan seconded by Mr. Dales the Reeve was allowed the price of 2 Twelve inch tile which he sold, for his trouble in overseeing construction of new road near Haley's.

By-Law No 257 for the purpose of rendering certain parties liable for the expense that may be incurred through their failure to remove obstructions from Road Allowances was then introduced and on Motion of Mr. McDellan, seconded by Mr. McEwan read a first time. On motion of Mr. Elliott seconded by Mr. Dales said By-Law No. 257 was then read a second and third time short and passed.
