

Foresters Falls Jan 13th 1908

The members of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross elected for 1908 met this day at 11 o'clock A.M. The members elect; viz. David Cooke, Reeve, James McEwan, Mr. John Oates, Andrew Rathwell Jr and John Jamieson, Councillors were all present, Each having made the necessary declarations of qualification and office, the Council was duly constituted the Reeve in the chair

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. Mr. McEwan then gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of providing for the payment of salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the year 1908.

Mr. Oates gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-Law for the purpose of appointing public officers for the Township for the year 1908.

The Council then adjourned for one hour on re-assembling, by-law No. 258 for the purpose of providing for the payment of public moneys for the year 1908 was then introduced and on motion of Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. Rathwell, read a first-time.

By-Law No 259 for the appointment of public officers for the year 1908 was then introduced and on motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Jamieson read a first-time. On motion of Rathwell seconded by Mr. McEwan By-law No 258 was then read a second and third time short and passed.
