

Foresters Falls March 7th 1908

A regular meeting of Council was held herethis day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the Chair.

The Minutes of last Meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of bills and accounts were ^{and considered} presented.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. McEwan the following alterations were made in the List of Patroasters and officers of the Board of Health.

The Council then adjourned for one hour.

After adjournment, on motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Rathwell the clerk was instructed to have a notice published in the "Cobden Sun" warning all parties who have been previously notified to remove their fences from the road allowance, that if they neglect or fail to do so by the First day of September next, actions for damages will be immediately thereafter taken against them by the Council.

Mr. Oates then gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the issue of debentures to the amount of \$1750. to raise a loan for the erection and equipment of a school house for School Section No. 9. Ross as requisitioned for by the Trustees of said School Section.

Moved by D. McEwan seconded by J. Oates that no action be taken on R. Hales request with regard to Statute Labor, and that Peter Nilson be required to perform his Statute Labor in Road Division No. 41 (Gas. Childerhosie) Carried By-Law No. 260 to provide by way of debentures for a loan of \$1750 for the erection and equipment of a school house in and for ss No. 9 was then introduced and on motion of Mr. Jamieson

seconded by Mr. McEwan, read a first time.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at next regular meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the purpose of conveying by Deed to William Humphries the road allowance between the third and the fourth Concessions of the Township of Ross opposite Lot No. 27.

Moved by Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. Rathwell that in case of washouts or other injuries ^{requiring repairs} to the roads or bridges occurring before the next meeting of Council the councillor most convenient to the place where the repairs are required be authorized to have such repairs made forthwith. Carried

On Motion of Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. Dales By-Law No. 260 was then read a second and third time short and passed.
