



Mr. Rathwell then introduced By-Law No 261, of which he had given notice, for the purpose of conveying by deed to Arthur Humphries that portion of Road Allowance lying between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> Concessions and opposite to Lot No. 27

On motion of Mr. Cates seconded by Mr. Jamison said by-law was then read a first time.

On motion of Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. Cates the Council agreed to purchase from John Rose the gravel on a piece of land 81 ft by 22 1/2 ft for the sum of \$15<sup>00</sup> and to grant the sum of \$25<sup>00</sup> towards gravelling the Pembroke-Cobden Road west of Muskrat Lake.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. McEwan by-law No 261 was then read a second and third time, short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Cates the Clerk was instructed to have a deed drawn conveying a portion of Town Hall site in Procter's Fields to the Orange Lodge, said Lodge to pay <sup>therefor</sup> the sum of \$30<sup>00</sup> and the cost of conveyance.

On motion of Mr. McEwan seconded by Mr. Jamison, A. Rathwell, S. Cook and W. J. Cates were appointed a committee to interview Albert Wallace with a view to purchasing a gravel pit from him.

On motion of Mr. Cates seconded by Mr. Jamison, Wm. Morduek was re-engaged as Road Machine Operator at \$2 per day.

On motion of Mr. Cates, seconded by Mr. Jamison the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:

Foresters Falls June 27<sup>th</sup> 1908

The regular meeting of Council met here this day at 10 A.M. all the members being present. The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted.
