Foresters Falls June 27th 1908

The regular meeting of Council met here this day at 10 A.M. all the members being present. The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted. On Motion of Mr McEwan seconded by Mr Rattray Bylaw No 253 which provided for the granting of a sum of ten cents per rod for wire fences on the north side of certain roads was extended until repealed. On Motion of Mr McEwan seconded by Mr James a Road Planer was purchased from Mr Abbott for \$50 to be paid Dec 31 1908. The Council then adjourned for one hour. On again meeting it was moved by Mr McEwan

and seconded by Mr Oates that \$40 be expended
 grading road near Haley's provided that the
 parties immediately concerned contribute \$20 ^{each}
 for the same purpose carried
 28 Dollars out of the above grant was paid to
 Mr Rathwell to be expended as the work progresses
 The committee appointed at last meeting of Council
 to negotiate with Albert Wallace for the purchase
 of a gravel pit reported in favor of paying
 him \$500 for five years use of a piece of land
 20 yds by 45 yds or if the supply on this
 area proved deficient 10 yds each way to be added
 the Council to be responsible for any unnecessary
 damage done. Their report was adopted
 On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr James
 Mr Oates was instructed to examine Rock at
 Roaches gate Queens Line and report at next
 Meeting of Council.

and Horton Carried.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by
Mr McEwan the Reeve was instructed to
interview John Rose with reference to ditch
to take water from Road Allowance.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by
Mr Jamieson the Reeve was authorized and
instructed to look after those parties who
have been notified to remove their fences
from Road Allowance by September 1st next
and in event of their failure to do so
