The Municipal Council met here this day
at 10 o'clock A.M. all the members being present.
The minutes of previous meeting were read and
adopted. After considering sundry bills
and communications the council
adjourned for dinner.

On again meeting it was moved by
Mr McEwan and seconded by Mr Rathwell
that the Clerk be instructed to apply to the
Lieutenant Governor in Council for a
Government survey of that portion of Road
Allowance lying between the Seventh and the
Eighth Concessions and extending from
lot No 22 to the Town line between Ross
and Horton Carried.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by
Mr McEwan the Reeve was instructed to
interview John Rose with reference to ditch
to take water from Road Allowance.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by
Mr Jamieson the Reeve was authorized and
instructed to look after those parties who
have been notified to remove their fences
from Road Allowance by September 1st and
and in event of their failure to do so

to hand the matter at once to a solicitor with a view to their prosecution.

On Motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Oates the Reeve and Treasurer were authorized to effect a loan of \$600.00 to defray the current expenses of the Township.

On Motion of Mr Oates seconded by Mr McEwen the following bills and accounts were passed and orders drawn on the Treasurer for payment thereof: Robert Haley drawing paid \$25.00, Statute Labor Refund 8.00, James Hardicks for work on bridge at McLaughlins \$28.00, John R. Byce do. \$39.00, John Gould for work on con 4 \$14.50, William Nolan work on Moccas Hill \$15, R. R. Byce Statute Labor Refund \$29.00, Michael Roach work on bridge on Goulds line \$15.00, John Ross for Gravel pit \$15.00, Canadian Road Machine Company Repairs for Grader 22.50, ~~John Jeffrey~~ P. R. Ponder Township share of putting in culvert \$2.00, Francis Guest Cedars for Mill Creek Bridge \$41.68, Robert Bulmer Culvert Tile \$193.00.
