

Foresters Hall Oct 3rd 1908

The regular meeting of Council met here this day, at 10 o'clock A.M., all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of previous meeting were read & adopted.

Mr. Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to authorize the levying the necessary rates for the present year. The Council then adjourned for one hour. On re-assembling, it was moved by Mr. McEwan and seconded by Mr. Rathwell that the offer of John Crozier to give the Council a piece of land around mill between Lots 16 & 17 in the 2nd Con. for road and to fence the same for the sum of \$35⁰⁰ be accepted. Carried

By-Law No. 262 to provide for the levying of the necessary rates for the current year was there introduced by Mr. Jamieson and on his motion seconded by Mr. Oates, read a first time.

On motion of Mr. McEwan, seconded by Mr. Oates the sum of \$3. was paid to Mr. McLaughlin for buying a steer and the Clerk was instructed to collect the amount from the owner of the animal.

On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Jamieson John Robinson was instructed to take eight 12 in tile row in Saml Johnston's Road Division to make a culvert in his (Robinson's) Division.

On motion of Mr. Oates, seconded by Mr. Jamieson the sum of \$10 was granted towards putting a wire bridge across narrows opposite Joseph Jeffrey's.

On motion of Mr. Oates, seconded by Mr. Rathwell By-Law No. 262 was there read a second and third time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwan the following bills and accts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof.
