Forester's Falls Dec 7<sup>th</sup>

The regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present. The Reeve in the chair. The minutes of previous meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of communications and accounts were read and considered, after which the Council adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the purpose of appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks to hold the ensuing Municipal Election. On motion of Mr McEwan seconded by Mr McEwan J. Pettigrew was allowed a refund of \$8<sup>00</sup> on account of School Taxes for 1908.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Rathwell the clerk was instructed to enquire of the Reeve of Horton his authority for asking the Township of Ross to share in the maintenance of that part of the Government Road extending from the Town Line between Ross and Horton southward to the Balys Station - Portage-Du-Fort Road and to be kind enough to forward a copy of any agreement between the two Townships regarding this matter that may be in the possession of the Township of Horton.

Mr Jamieson then introduced by Law No 263 for the purpose of appointing D. R. Officers and Poll Clerks for to hold the ensuing Municipal Elections and on his motion seconded by Mr Oates said by-law was read a first time. On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr McEwan the blanks in By-Law No 263 were filled in as follows:
