

Foresters Falls May 29th 1909.

The municipal Council of the Township of Ross met here this day at 10 o'clock A.M. as a Court of Revision. All the members were present, the Reeve in the Chair.

The members having been sworn the Clerk read the following appeals: (1) From W^m Wilcox claiming that he was improperly assessed, and that in any event his assessment of \$500 was too high. (2) From Colin Bruce claiming that his assessment of \$2400 was at least \$400 too high. On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. McEwen W^m Wilcox's assessment was reduced \$200. No action was taken on Colin Bruce's appeal on the ground that it had not been filed with the clerk within the time prescribed by law. The Court then carefully examined the assessment Roll making a number of corrections and additions thereto with a view to rendering it a correct basis for the compilation of the Voters List. After which, on motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Rathwell the Roll as revised was accepted. The Court then adjourned.

At 1 o'clock P.M. the municipal Council met for the transaction of general Township business. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved. The following communications were then presented (1) a letter from the Clerk of Horton re closing part of Govt. Road (2) A legal opinion from P. White on this question (3) A letter from N. Reid M.P.C. with reference to colonization Road Grants, (4) Sundry Bills and accounts.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Oates the former was authorized to give out a job of stumping the side line through Concession 5 between Lot 15 and 16.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Oates the Reeve was instructed to engage Mr. P. White to act in the interests of the Township of Ross in opposing the closing of that part of Govt Road between the Ross & Horton boundary line and the Portage du Fort - Haley Station Road as threatened by the Council of the Township of Horton.

 An account and letter from the Clerk of Horton and
 sundry other Bills and accounts were read and considered
 The Reeve reported that he had secured a Dumping
 Ground for the use of the Village of Foresters Falls from
 S. M. Williams at a rental of \$3. per annum.

On motion of Mr. McIwen, seconded by Mr. Oates, ^{Council}
 granted one days work with Road Grader on the side
 Road in Thos. Rollins Road Division. On motion,
 Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Oates the Clerk was in-
 structed to notify J. Scobie to remove his fence from the
 Road allowance across 4th Con Line between Lots 25 in
 the 4th and the 5th Concessions. On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr Rathwell
 the Reeve and Treas. were authorized to borrow from the Bank of Ottawa
 the sum of \$100⁰⁰ to meet the current expenses of the Township.
