Foresters Falls July 3rd 1909

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day
 all the members except Mr. Jamieson being present
 The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted
 An account and letter from the Clerk of Horton and
 sundry other Bills and accounts were read and considered
 The Reeve reported that he had secured a Dumping
 Ground for the use of the Village of Foresters Falls from
 S. M. Williams at a rental of \$3. per annum.

On motion of Mr. McIwen, seconded by Mr. Oates, ^{Council}
 granted one days work with Road Grader on the side
 Road in Thos. Rollins Road Division. On motion,
 Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Oates the Clerk was in-
 structed to notify J. Scobie to remove his fence from the
 Road allowance across 4th Con Line between Lots 25 in
 the 4th and the 5th Concessions. On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr Rathwell
 the Reeve and Treas. were authorized to borrow from the Bank of Ottawa
 the sum of \$100⁰⁰ to meet the current expenses of the Township.

On motion of Mr Oates seconded by Mr. Jamieson the Clerk was instructed to order 3 No 1 Road Scrapers from H. McLurg. On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Jamieson the appointment of Geo. Pettigrew as Sanitary Inspector was confirmed and his name substituted in By-Law No 263 for the appointment of Public Officers for the present year instead of that of Hugh Byce who has declined to act. On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwen the Reeve was authorized to endeavor to secure a suitable Dumping Ground for the use of the residents of Forestus Falls. On motion of Mr. Kirk seconded by Mr. McEwen C. J. Barber was appointed Pathmaster instead of James Jack Jr, and Lorenza Edwards instead of Walter Price.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Patton the resignation of W. S. Coleman, F. J. Mosman & J. Ellis as Road Commissioners for the Village of Forestus Falls and the election of Geo. Pettigrew Jr to act in their stead was accepted and confirmed. On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Jamieson the Clerk was instructed to notify the Reeve of Boston that the Council of the Township of Ross intend opposing the closing of that part of Govt. Road between Town Line and Bolton's old tavern stand.

The Clerk was instructed to give the necessary notice of the intention of the Council to pass a By-Law at the next regular meeting for the purpose of closing that part of Gould's ^{Road} running through Lots 17, 18, 19 and 20.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Oates the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment of the same:

On motion of Mr McEwen seconded by Mr. Oates the sum of \$15 was granted Robt. Haley to assist in graveling the Cobden-Cambroke Road. On motion of Mr Oates, seconded by Mr Rathwell the Clerk was instructed to give Edward J. Pettigrew an order on John Waite for 4m. Tile to put in clay hill on Queens Line. On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. McEwen the Reeve was instructed to engage Mr. White to defend the Municipality should the Township of Horton institute proceedings for the recovery of their claim against this Township. On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Oates the Clerk was instructed to notify the Clerk of the Township of Horton that this Council are still of the opinion that they are not liable for the claim for damages and repairs made by the former Township. On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr McEwen the sum of \$10 was granted towards cutting down hill at Dow Edmunds on the Garden of Eden Road. A petition from a number of parties was presented and strongly supported by Mr. Gibson in opposition to the passing of the proposed By-Law for closing a certain portion of Goulds Road. Several others just as strongly supported the By-Law. Considering that it would be more in the public interest to close a greater portion of said road Mr McEwen gave notice that he would at the next regular meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of closing that portion of Goulds Road running through the S 1/2 half of Lot 15 and through Lots 16, 17, 18, 19 & 20

On motion of Mr Oates seconded by Mr Rathwell the following Bills and accts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment of the same \$6

Foresters Hall Aug 7th 1909

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the Chair. The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted. Sundry Bills and accounts were presented. The Reeve paid into the Treasury the sum of Twelve Dollars received from S. E. Mitchell for fines due the Municipality.

Mr Oates gave notice that at this meeting of Council he would introduce a by-law to provide for the issue of Debentures to the amount of \$5000 to provide for the erection and equipment of a new School house and for the purchase and improvement of an addition to the old School site for S. S. No. 6 Ross as requisitioned for by the Trustees of said Section.

Mr. McEwen then introduced the by-law of which he had given notice at the last meeting for the purpose of closing up that portion of Goulds Road running through the South half of Lot 15 and through Lots 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 in the Township of Ross. The Council then adjourned for one hour. On re-assembling at 1 o'clock Mr. Oates introduced the by-law of which he had given notice providing for the issue of Debentures for S. S. No 6. Ross said by-law to be known as by-law ^{no} 266, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jamieson, it was read a first time.
