Foresters Hall Aug 7th 1909

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the Chair. The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted. Sundry Bills and accounts were presented. The Reeve paid into the Treasury the sum of Twelve Dollars received from S. E. Mitchell for fines due the Municipality.

Mr Oates gave notice that at this meeting of Council he would introduce a by-law to provide for the issue of Debentures to the amount of \$5000 to provide for the erection and equipment of a new School house and for the purchase and improvement of an addition to the old School site for S. S. No. 6 Ross as requisitioned for by the Trustees of said Section.

Mr. McEwen then introduced the by-law of which he had given notice at the last meeting for the purpose of closing up that portion of Goulds Road running through the South half of Lot 15 and through Lots 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 in the Township of Ross. The Council then adjourned for one hour. On re-assembling at 1 o'clock Mr. Oates introduced the by-law of which he had given notice providing for the issue of Debentures for S. S. No 6. Ross said by-law to be known as by-law ^{no} 266, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jamieson, it was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. McEwen Messrs Kirk, Oates and Jamieson were appointed a deputation to examine the road in lieu of Con. 10 near saw-mill and to report upon the advisability of changing the location of said Road. On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Rathwell by-law No 267 for the purpose of closing up a portion of Goulds Road was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. McEwen the Treasurer was authorized to pay Robt Bulmer for the job on bridge near James Mathison's upon the certificate of the overseer Mr. Kirk that the work is satisfactorily completed. On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Rathwell by-law No 266 was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Jamieson the Reeve and Treasurer were authorized to borrow the sum of Eight hundred Dollars from The Bank of Ottawa, Cobden to defray the current expenses of the Municipality. On motion of Mr. Oates, seconded by Mr. Jamieson by-law No 267 was then read a second and third time short and passed. On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Rathwell the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for their payment.
