

Foresters Falls April 2nd 1910

Council met here this day at 10 o'clock A.M. all the members being present. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of communications were read and considered. The Government having expressed their approval of draft by-law No 270, said by-law was on motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Oates, read a third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Mc Ewen the following changes were made in Patrollers list for present year:
J. J. Moore appointed instead of J. D. Thompson
Robert H. Elliott John A. Ferguson
Patrick O'Hara Col. Mc Ginty
Alex. Thompson Harry Lipsey

Mr. Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to amend by-law No 270 as suggested by the Department of Public Works.

Mr. Oates gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the Queen's Line Telephone Association to erect poles along the Public Roads of the Township. The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr. Jamieson introduced by-law No 276 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Mc Ewen said by-law was read a first time. Mr. Oates then introduced by-law No 277 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Rathwell said by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Nolan presented an appeal from certain interested ratepayers who offered to contribute gratis in labor an equivalent to the amount the Council would grant towards cutting down Moran's hill. In response to this appeal the Council granted the sum of \$26 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for the purpose mentioned.

On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. Jamieson the Clerk was instructed to ask the Minister of Public Works to give the result of his promised investigation in the matter of the \$500 voted by the Legislature in 1907 for the improvement of certain roads in the Township of Ross but which has not been expended therein.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Cates by-law No 276 was then read a second and third time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwen by-law No 277 was then read a second and third time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwen, Wm Nolan was appointed overseer of job on Moscanis hill. On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Cates the Clerk was instructed to write Alfred Roach that it is unnecessary to give any further notice of the closing of Gould's Road. On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Rathwell, Wm R. Kirk and Wm J. Cates were appointed a deputation to interview the

Horton Council with reference to the disputed portion of Govt. road between Town Line and Bolton's old Tavern stand.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Cates the Clerk was instructed to order 6 scrapers for use on the Public roads.

On motion of Mr. Cates seconded by Mr. McEwen, the following bills and acc'ts, were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:
