

Foresters Falls May 14 1910
Council met here at 10 o'clock A.M. this day all the members being present, the Revere in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of communications were then read amongst which were a letter from Alfred Roach forbidding this Council or any future Council to contribute towards the maintenance of the floating bridge across Ormsteads Lake, and another from Chiron and Geale advising the repeal of the by-law for closing Goulds Road. Quite a number of ratepayers also appeared before Council to urge the repeal of said by-law. The council decided to take no further action in the matter at present.

Messrs. Kirk and Oates reported the result of their interview with the Council of Horton with reference to the maintenance of that part of Government Road between Town Line and Bolton's old tavern stand. The Horton Council would agree to the deputations proposals, saying that they wished the piece of road in question to be considered "a road in lieu of the Town Line" or that hereafter each Township would be equally responsible for its maintenance. On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwan, Messrs. Kirk, Oates and Rathwell were appointed a deputation to meet a deputation from the Horton Council at Bolton's old tavern stand at 2 o'clock P.M. on Friday the 27th inst. with a view to effecting a mutually satisfactory and final settlement of the matter, either by providing for the maintenance of the old road or by the purchase of another road in lieu thereof.

Messrs. D. Tripp and John L. McLaren presented a numerous signed petition praying for a grant of \$300 for the improvement of that part of Govt Road between James Coads and Lot No. 21. In view of the length and character of the road the Council decided that it would be false economy to spend such a small amount thereon, and that it would be better to include it amongst the roads to be improved in 1911 under the Permanent Road scheme.

The Council then adjourned for one hour. On re-assembly Mr. Gibson appeared before them asking to have

 Mr. Rathwell was appointed to interview Mr. Scobie about the matter. Mr. Jamieson was appointed to examine the culvert on road leading to Hugh Pettigrew's to see if it is in a state of repair. The deputation appointed to meet the deputation from Horton were instructed to examine the piece of road referred to in petition presented by Messrs. Tripp and McEwen and report at next meeting of Council.

Commissaries for the different roads to be improved this year under the Permanent Road scheme were appointed as follows:

John Jamieson for road leading from Govt. road towards Grant's settlement

Wm. R. Kirk, Cobden Road from Govt. Road to School House S.S. No. 9.

J. McEwen, Cobden Road from Gibson's gravel pit westward, and road on Con 2

Wm. J. Bates, Queen's Line from Lot 10 to Lot 20

A. Rathwell for Road from Queen's line at Cheese Factory ^{Halley's} southward towards

each commissioner to have authority to appoint a foreman

It was decided that the way on boxes for drawing gravel are to be 12 ft. long and 12 inches deep with end boards, or of equal capacity.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Rathwell, Wm.

Black was granted the privilege of taking gravel from road opposite Wm. Grant's provided that he leave the road in good and safe condition.

On motion of Mr. Bates seconded by Mr. Jamieson the Reeve was authorized to procure a dumping ground for manure from the Village of Foresters Falls.

On motion of Mr. Bates, seconded by Mr. McEwen the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment of the same:
