

Foresters Falls July 2nd 1910

A regular Meeting of Council was held here this day at the usual hour, all the members being present except Mr. Jamieson, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the Special meeting held on June 9th and of the last regular meeting were read and approved save and except the motion allowing Mr Kirk his Statute Labor for operating road drag which was amended to read from Lot 10 to Foresters Falls instead of "from Provingline to Foresters Falls."

On motion of Mr. Oates, seconded by Mr. Rathwell Mr. McEwen was instructed to have the sum of \$10 expended on the Town Line between Zion Church and Hawthorn's corner provided that the Township of Westmeath agree to spend a similar amount for the same purpose. The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling at 1 o'clock P.M. it was moved by Mr. McEwen and seconded by Mr. Oates that the Treas. be authorized to pay orders signed by R. M. Storie in favor of James Gorman, Joseph Shannon and Thomas Smith for work done on new road near Bolton's old tavern stand. Carried.

On motion of Mr. Oates seconded by Mr. McEwen John C. Muddock was allowed his Statute Labor until the 10th Con. is repaired for granting the privilege of a road through his farm.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Oates the Clerk was instructed to prepare a statements of the Statute Labor and money expended on the Town Line ^{between} Ross and Bromby and between Ross and Westmeath and submit them to the Councils of the respective Townships.

On motion of Mr. Oates, seconded by Mr. Rathwell, the sum of Ten Dollars was granted for drawing clay for road in lieu of Town Line opposite August Boese, provided Horton grant an equal amount for the same purpose.

On Motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Rathwell the sum of Ten Dollars was granted for blasting rock on Town Line opposite J. Deans

On motion of Mr Mc Ewen seconded by Mr. Rathwell the following bills and accts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof.

Foresters Falls Oct 1st 1910

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting were read and approved. A number of bills and accts were received and considered. Amongst the communications received and read the following were the most important:-

- (1) From the Department of Public Works with reference to a by-law to improve the main and leading roads of the Township during the ensuing year.
- (2) From Jas. R. Davidson, Reeve of Westmeath with reference to the refund to the rural municipalities, of that portion of the County Equivalent School Grant from which the urban municipalities were wrongfully exempted in the year 1907.
- (3) A numerously signed petition from the ratepayers of Grants Settlement praying the council to have the road leading from the Government Road to and through said settlement.
