

Foresters Falls Dec. 3rd 1910

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present, The Reeve in the Chair.

The Minutes of last meeting were read and adopted. Several accounts were presented and considered.

Rev. Mr. Craig appeared before Council to solicit the usual grant to Foresters Falls Public Library, to which ^{no opposition was offered} Mrs. Thos. Appleby urged the Council for a grant to pay the funeral expenses of the late James White.

On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Rathwell \$50⁰⁰ was granted for this purpose. The petition presented at last meeting of Council from a number of ratepayers for Grants settlement was considered. On account of the lateness of the season, the Council thought it proper to defer taking action in the matter this year. The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr. Oates gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the appointment of Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks to hold the ensuing Municipal Election. On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Rathwell the bill presented by the Horton Council was accepted after deducting \$3.25 therefrom on account of the wages allowed overseer in excess of the understanding ^{with this Council}. Mr. Oates then introduced by-law No 281 to provide for the appointment of Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks to hold the municipal election and on his motion seconded by Mr. Rathwell said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Jamieson the blanks in by-law No 281 were filled in as follows:

Mr. Oates gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to increase the remuneration of the Reeve and Councillors for attending at the meetings of Council hereafter from \$1.50 ^{as at present} to \$2.50 per day.

Mr. Oates then introduced by-law No. 282 to provide for increasing the remuneration of the Reeve and Councillors to \$2.50 per day and on his motion seconded by Mr. Rathwell said by-law was read a first time.
