

Foresters Falls, April 1st 1911

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. After sundry communications and accounts had been read and considered, Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to amend by-law No. 280.

Mr. Payne gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the Snake River Telephone Association to erect Telephone poles and to stretch Telephone wires thereon along the Pembroke - Cobden road from the Town-line between Ross and Westmeath to the Village of Cobden.

Mr. Jamieson then introduced by-law No 290 of which he had given notice at a previous meeting of Council to authorize and provide for the putting of tags on all dogs owned within the municipality and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Payne said by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Jamieson gave notice that he would at the next regular meeting of Council introduce a by-law to establish Grants Settlement Road to a width of 40 feet. On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Barber M. J. Oates was appointed pathmaster of Road Division No 50 instead of Allan Gilmore and John A. Wilson pathmaster of Road Division No 13 instead of Saml Johnston.

Mr. McEwen then introduced by-law No 288 to amend by-law No. 280 and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jamieson the by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Payne then introduced by-law No. 289 to authorize the Snake River Telephone Association to erect a Telephone Line along the Pembroke - Cobden road from the Town-Line between Ross and Westmeath to the Village of Cobden and on his motion seconded by Mr. Barber said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. McEwen

By-law No 290 was then read a second and third time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Payne, seconded by Mr Jamieson the following were appointed Overseers of the Roads to be improved this season under the Permanent Road Scheme:-

J. McEwen	Western Section Road No 1
John Jamieson	Road No 2
W ^m Payne	Roads Nos 3 & 5
Edward Barber	Road No 4

On motion of Mr Barber seconded by Mr Payne by-law No. 288 was then read a second & third time short & passed

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. McEwen By-law No 289 was then read a 2nd and 3rd time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Barber, seconded by Mr. McEwen Messrs. Kirk and Payne were appointed to see about getting gravel for Road No 5. and the former was also instructed to interview Edward B. Bulmer with reference to the purchase of a Gravel pit for use on the Government Road.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr. Barber the following bills and accts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:-
