

Foresters Falls Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> 1911

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present, the reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting of council were read & approved. A number of communications, bills and accounts were read and considered.

Mr Barber reported that the reeve and he thought it advisable to postpone the purchase of a gravel pit from Jas. A. McLaughlin for another year.

Mr. McEwen reported with reference to bridge at Thomas Gibsons. No action was taken with reference to survey of road allowance between Cns. 3 & 4 opposite Lots 11, 12 and 13.

On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Payne \$10 was granted towards improving Town line between Ross and Cobden west of railway crossing provided Cobden grant an equal amount for the same purpose.

The Council then adjourned for one hour. On again meeting a number of ratepayers discussed the question of the re-opening of Goulds Road. Finally it was moved by Mr. Payne, and seconded by Mr. Barber that the by-law that had been introduced by the latter providing for the re-opening of Goulds Road, be now read a first time. Messrs. Payne and Barber supported the motion, Messrs. McEwen and Jamieson opposed it. The Reeve voted in the negative and the motion was lost.

On motion of Mr. Barber, seconded by Mr. McEwen the amount to be paid John Jamieson for gravel for road Number 2 under good roads scheme for present year was left to arbitration and F. J. Mearns was appointed Arbitrator on behalf of the Township.

On motion of Mr. Payne, seconded by Mr. Jamieson Jas. Gilmore was granted 7 eight inch tile to be used on road allowance between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Cns. opposite Lot 10.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. Payne H. Pettigrew and Saml. Murdoch were instructed to repair bridge on forced road through Lot 11 Cor. 9.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Jamieson, Joseph Jeffrey was granted a sum not to exceed \$15 to repair road on hill at John Logan's



On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Barber, the  
Reeve and Treasurer were authorized to borrow \$175 from the  
Bank of Ottawa to defray the current expenses of the Municipality.
