

Foresters Falls Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 1911

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present the Reeve in the chair

The minutes of previous meeting of Council were read & adopted

Mr Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the levying of rates to meet the County rate, the Township Debenture, the current expenses of Municipality, the Township School Grant, the Debentures of School Sections Nos 6, 9, 10, 12 & 13 and the amounts requisitioned for by the Trustees of the various School Sections. The Council then adjourned & met here

On a future meeting, it was moved by Mr Jamieson and seconded by Mr Barber that in future no subvert title be given out without an order from the Council or from a Councillor. Carried

Mr McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the improvement of certain main and leading roads next year under the terms of the Colonization Road Act.

Mr Jamieson then introduced by-law No 292 of which he had given notice, to authorize the levying the necessary rates for the present year, and on his motion, seconded by Mr Payne, said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr McEwen, seconded by Mr Payne the Reeve and Treasurer were authorized to effect a temporary loan from the Bank of Ottawa, Cobden of the sum of \$360 to meet the current expenses of the Municipality

Mr McEwen then introduced by-law No 293 of which he had given notice, to provide for the improvement of certain main and leading roads under the Colonization Road Act and on his motion seconded by Mr Barber the by-law was read a first time

On motion of Mr Payne seconded by Mr Jamieson the blanks in by-law No. 292 were filled in as follows:-

 read a second and third time short and passed.
