

Foresters Falls Jan 8<sup>th</sup> 1912

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present. The W<sup>m</sup> R. Kirk the Reverelect subscribed to the Declaration of qualification and Office. The Clerk read a protest from two ratepayers against the election of Messrs. Barber, Jamison, McEwen and Payne as Councillors on the ground of an irregularity in the Nominations proceedings on the 1<sup>st</sup> inst.

Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the holding of another election for the election of four Councillors for the Township of Ross for the remainder of the current year.

Mr. McEwen then introduced By-Law No 296 of which he had given notice to provide for the election of Councillors for the remainder of present year and on his motion seconded by Mr. Payne said By-Law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jamison seconded by Mr. Barber <sup>the blanks in</sup> By-Law No 296 <sup>was properly filled in</sup> was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

Messrs. Barber, Jamison, McEwen and Payne then each put in a Disclaimer to the office of Councillor to which they had been declared elected by the Returning Officer.

The Council then adjourned sine die.
