

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, the Reeve presiding, Messrs Barber, Murdock, McEwen, and Payne the newly elected Councillors each made the necessary declarations of qualification and office. The minutes of the two last meetings of Council were read and approved. A number of bills and accounts were presented and considered. Applications for aid for the Salvation Army Rescue Work and the Hospital for Sick Children Toronto were also received.

Mr McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to provide for the appointment of Township officers for the present year.

Mr Payne gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to authorize and provide for the payment of Salaries, bills and accounts, and all other necessary expenditures for the present year.

On motion of Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Barber the tender of A. P. Haydon of the Golden Sun for the Township printing for the present year for the sum of \$52⁰⁰ was accepted. On motion of Mr Payne seconded by Mr McEwen, the Clerk was instructed to order six copies of the Municipal World for the use of the Council and Clerk.

The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr McEwen introduced bylaw No 294 to provide for the appointment of Township officers for the ^{present} year and on his motion seconded by Mr Barber the by-law was read a first time.

Mr Payne then introduced by-law No 295 to authorize and provide for the payment of all necessary expenditures for the ^{current} year and on his motion seconded by Mr Barber the bylaw was read a first time.

Mr Hugh Byce appeared before the Council to urge the prohibition of the sale of cigarettes on account of the danger of fire caused by their careless use as well as on account of their injurious effects on youth.

Mr McEwen then gave notice that he would at the next regular meeting of Council introduce a by-law to prohibit the sale of cigarettes in the Municipality.

Mr Mosam a member of the street committee of Forester's Falls then appeared before the Council, first to urge that the Council take some further action towards preventing cattle running at large in the Village of Forester's Falls and secondly to inquire if a special tax could be imposed on the rate-payers of said Village to provide street lamps &c. It was decided that the Council had no authority to pass such by-laws unless they applied to the whole Municipality. Mr Mosam was advised that the only legal way to secure the objects he advocated was by making the Village into a police Village.

On motion of Mr Payne seconded by Mr Barber the blanks in by-law No 294 were filled in as follows: and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed
