Foresters Falls Sept 14th 1912

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of communications and bills and accts. were presented and considered.

Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for the levying of Rates to pay the County Rate, the Township Debt, the Township Rate, the General School Rate, the Debentures of S. S. numbers 6, 9, 10, 12 and 13 and the Trustees levy for the various School sections.

On motion of Mr. Payne, seconded by Mr. Barber the Women's Institute and the Street Committee of Foresters Falls were granted permission to erect poles for street lamps along the streets in said Village. The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On again meeting Mr. McEwen introduced the by-law of which he had given notice to authorize the levying all necessary rates for the present year and on his motion seconded by Mr. Payne said by-law was read a first time. On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. Payne the Reeve was instructed to try to secure compensation for the gravel taken for railway purposes from road opposite Lot 2 Con. 5.

On motion of Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. Barber the Reeve and Treasurer were authorized to borrow the sum of \$375⁰⁰ from the Bank of Ottawa & Order to meet the current expenses of the Municipality. On motion of Mr. Payne seconded by Mr. Barber the blanks in by-law No 301 for the levying of rates were filled in as follows:

Foresters Falls Oct 19th 1912

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day at 10 o'clock P.M., all the members being present except Mr. Murdock, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted.

Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the improvement of certain main and leading roads in the year 1913 under the terms of the Colonization Roads Act.

On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. Payne the sum of Fifty Dollars was granted to finish the Cobden - Foresters Falls road near Luffys Hill.

Mr. McEwen then introduced by-law No. 302 of which he had given notice for the purpose of designating and providing for the improvement of certain main and leading roads next year under the terms of the Colonization Roads Act and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Payne said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Payne it was resolved to ascertain the voice of the ratepayers on the advisability of commencing the Statute Labor at the rate of \$1⁰⁰ per day by taking a vote on the question at the next Municipal Election.

The Council then adjourned for one hour. On re-assembling Mr. Barber moved seconded by Mr. Payne that the blanks in by-law No. 302 be filled in as follows:-

- Road No 1. On the line between Cons 6 & 7 from Lot 22 to Lot 24 \$200
 - Road No 2. Running in a southerly direction through Lots 25, 26 & 27
- Across Concession 8
