

Foresters Falls Jan 13th 1913

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day at 11 o'clock A.M. All the members being present. The members-elect, viz. Wm R. Kirk Reeve, Duncan McEwen Edward Barber, A. Rathwell Jr and John Jamieson Councilors-elect having made the declarations of qualification and of office. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read & adopted. A few bills and acts were read and considered.

Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the appointment of Township Officers for the present year.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for the payment of salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the present year.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at the next meeting of Council introduce a by-law to commute the Statute Labor in those Road Divisions adjacent to those roads that have been improved under the Good Roads Scheme.

The Council then adjourned for one hour. On again meeting Mr. McEwen introduced by-law No 304 of which he had given notice to provide for the appointment of Public Officers for the present year and on his motion seconded by Mr. Barber the by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Rathwell then introduced by-law No 305 of which he had given notice to authorize and provide for the payment of salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the present year and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jamieson said by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Samuel Johnston was then heard ^{reference to} with opening up Con 7 through Lots 5 & 6. The Council took no action on the matter.

On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. Rathwell the blanks in by-law No. 304 were filled in as follows: and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Jamieson the clerk was instructed to order 6 copies of the Municipal World for the use of the Council and Clerk.

On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. McEwen each Councillor was authorized to procure what cedar he considers necessary for his section of the Township for the present year.
