On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Barber  
 Wm J. Jones was transferred from Road Division  
 No. 35 to Road Division No. 3.

The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr. McEwen gave notice that he  
 would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law  
 to authorize the Muskrat Lake Telephone Association  
 to erect a Telephone line along certain Public Roads  
 to be described therein.

Mr. Barber gave notice that he would, at this meeting  
 of Council introduce a by-law to amend by-law  
 No. 306 in so far as said by-law relates to Haley's Station  
 Telephone Association No. 2.

John McCulloch appeared before Council to ask that  
 he be transferred from S.S. No. 1 to S.S. No. 3. The Council  
 advised him to apply to the Trustees of the former Section  
 for a refund of his School Taxes in order that he might  
 pay them to the latter.

Mr. McEwen then introduced by-law No. 307 of which  
 he had given notice, to authorize the Muskrat Lake Telephone  
 Association to erect a Telephone line from the Town Line  
 between Ross and Westmeath along road through Con. 1 and  
 to the Cobden-Foresters Falls Road, also from a point opposite  
 Lot No. 8 in Con. 4 westward along Road Allowance between  
 Cons 3 and 4 to said Cobden-Foresters Falls Road, also from a  
 point in forced road through Lot 104 in Con. 3 westerly along  
 said forced road to the Cobden-Foresters Falls Road, also from

a point in Town Line between Ross & Cobden opposite Lot 6  
in Con 1 eastward along said Town Line to said Cobden  
Fresters Falls road, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Barber  
said by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Barber then introduced by-law No. 308 of which he had  
given notice for the purpose of amending by-law No. 306  
in so far as said by-law relates to Haley's Station Telephone  
Association No. 2 and on his motion seconded by Mr.  
Jamieson said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. Rathwell, the  
Clerk was instructed to ask the Renfrew Mercury and  
the Pembroke Observer for tenders for the Township  
printing for the current year.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwen  
by-law No. 307 was then read a 2<sup>nd</sup> and a 3<sup>rd</sup> time  
short and passed.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Barber  
By-law No. 308 was then read a 2<sup>nd</sup> and a 3<sup>rd</sup> time short & passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwen
