

Foresters Falls Dec. 15th 1913

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved. A petition from Alex Delarge and a number of other ratepayers praying the Council to have a survey made of that part of the Town line between Ross + Horton opposite Corn H. was received. A letter was read from C. J. Stewart, Clerk of Horton with reference to the opening of said Town line to Green Lake. A number of bills and acts were read & considered. Mr Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the purpose of appointing Deputy-Returning Officers and Poll Clerks to hold the ensuing Municipal Election.

On motion of Mr McEwen, seconded by Mr. Jamieson the petition of Alex. Delarge and others was laid over till next meeting of Council.

Rev. Mr. Inarturnaine gave a report of the work of the Children's Shelter at Pennew and solicited a grant for same.

On motion of Mr. Barber seconded by Mr. Jamieson the sum of \$20^{was granted} for this purpose.

Mr. Rathwell then introduced by-law No 313 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Barber said by-law was read a first-time. The Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling, it was moved by Mr. McEwen and seconded by Mr. Jamieson that the blanks in By-law No 313 be filled in as follows:-

and that the by-law be then read a second and third time short and finally passed. Carried

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Barber the annual grant of \$15 was made to the Foresters Falls Public Library.

On motion of Mr. Barber, seconded by Mr. McEwen the sum of \$20^{was granted} to John Gordon towards the maintenance of Robt. Gibson.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Jamieson the clerk was instructed to notify the owner of the East Half of Lot No. 16 Con 5 to have stumps removed from Con opposite said Lot, a complaint having been made that said stumps are obstructing the highway.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. Barber that the clerk ^{was} be instructed to notify the P. P. R. Co that the grade on crossing on Town Line between Ross and Cobden is not according to Statute and to request the Co. to have the same properly repaired.

On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Barber the following bills and accts. were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:-
