

Foresters Falls Sept 5 1916

A regular Meeting of Council was held here this day at the usual hour all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last regular meeting of Council and of the special meeting held on July 6th were read and approved.

A number of bills and accounts were presented & considered.

Mr Rathwell introduced by-law No 321 of which he had given notice to authorize and provide for the surveying and opening that part of the Town Line between Ross and Horton extending from the Garden Road in the 3rd Con eastward to Green Lake and on his motion seconded by Mr Jamieson the by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to effect a loan of \$600 from the Bank of Ottawa Cobden to defray the current expenses of the Township.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr Mc Ewen the sum of \$90 was granted to repair Town Line between Ross & Bromley provided Bromley grant an equal amount.

On motion of Mr. Mc Ewen seconded by Mr. Rathwell the sum of \$30 was granted to the Street Committee of Foresters Falls to assist in building cement walk.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr. Rathwell the name W. J. Moore was inserted in By-law No 321 and the by-law was then read a 2nd and 3rd time short and finally passed.

Mr. Jamieson then introduced by-law No 322 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Barber the by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr Barber seconded by Mr. Mc Ewen Mr. Jamieson was instructed to have road on hill at Colin Bruce's repaired.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr. Mc Ewen Mr Kirk was authorized to have Gravel pit at Howard's hill fenced in such a manner as to prevent the public from undermining Mr. Reynolds's fence.

On motion of Mr Mc Ewen seconded by Mr Barber by-law No 322 was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Barber the Revere was instructed to see if Mr. Bulmer would repair Cattle pass on road leading to Saml Mundrocks and if not repaired to have said cattle pass filled up.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Mc Ewen the following bills and accts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:-
