

Foresters Falls Dec 15<sup>th</sup> 1914

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved. A number of communications including sundry bills and accounts were presented and considered.

On motion of Mr Barber seconded by Mr. McEwen Five Dollars was granted towards the assistance of D. McNaughten. Mr McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the purpose of appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks to hold the ensuing Municipal election.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Jamieson Miss Johnston was granted the use of the Town Hall for School Concert for the sum of One Dollar.

Mr. McEwen then introduced By-Law No 326 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Rathwell the by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. McEwen the blanks in By-Law No 326 were filled in as follows:-

 and the bylaw was then read a 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> time short and passed.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Rathwell the Reeve and Messrs. Jamieson, McEwen, Rathwell, Barber and Jas. Childerhose were appointed a Committee with power to add to their number, to canvass the Township for donations to the Belgian Relief Fund, and the Reeve was instructed to communicate with Gerald V. White M.P., with reference to the forwarding of such donations.
