

Forester's Falls Nov. 13th 1915.

The Municipal Council of Ross Twp. met in the Town Hall the second Saturday in November. Present were Reeve W R Kirk and Councillors M Owen, Barber and Rathwell.

The minutes of the meeting held October 2nd and of the special meeting held October 10th in the school house of S. S. No. 8 were read and adopted.

Mr. David Headrick, Jr. who had been advised by Dr Brown of Forester's Falls and by a medical doctor of Pembroke to consult a specialist at Montreal, asked the council to assist him in doing so. The request was shelved.

On motion of Mr. Barber, seconded by Mr. Rathwell, the council adjourned one hour.

On resuming work the clerk was instructed to bill Cobden village ten dollars for use of road grader and the township of Bromley one dollar and fifty cents for one-half of road done on town line.

The following accounts and bills were approved and accepted and orders for the same were drawn on the Treasurer: Donald McNaughton, charity, \$5; Samuel Olmstead, digging ditch in front of Mr James Cook's, \$2; Lorenza Edmonds, drawing stone and scraping hill, \$6; W. R. Kirk, mailing Red Cross contributions and repairing road plainer, \$3.30; Thomas Neville,

work on road, \$1.50; Thomas Guest, cedar and work on culvert, \$21.55; John Rathwell, work on town line between Ross and Bromley and on side line, \$4. Total, \$43.35.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Barber, the work of the council was postponed till 10 a.m. December 15th. 1915.
