

Forester's Falls, Town Hall, Dec. 15th. 1915.

Municipal council met here this day. Present were Reeve W R Kirk, and councillors Duncan McEwen, John Jamieson, and Andrew Rathwell.

Rev. Hugh Craig interviewed the council re - Forester's Falls public library. He informally spoke of its finances and as a distributor of good books and incidentally said he thought the library a power for good and worthy of being assisted.

Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at this meeting of council introduce a by-law for the purpose of appointing deputy - returning officers and poll clerks for the ensuing election for 1916.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. McEwen, the council adjourned for one hour.

On resuming work, Mr. McEwen then introduced By-Law No. 333, of which he had given notice, and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Rathwell it was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. Rathwell, the blanks in By-Law No. 333 were filled in as follows: Deputy - returning officer for polling sub-division No. 1, John Mc Ginn; poll clerk for poll No. 1, Robert Hill; D.R.O. for poll No. 2, Niles G. Ross; poll clerk for No. 2, P.R. Pounder; D.R.O. for poll No. 3, R. Gould; poll clerk for poll

poll no. 3, John Neville; and it was then read a second and third times short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. McEwen, no action was taken, regarding communication from Post Office Department re rural routes, and the clerk was instructed to notify the said department to that effect.

Receipts were presented by the reeve from the secretary of the British Red Cross society to the amount of \$542.75, being the amount subscribed to said society by the township of Ross on Trafalgar Day, the 21st of October.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Jamieson, the sum of twenty dollars was granted to the Children's Aid Society of the County of Renfrew.
