

Forester's Falls, Town Hall, July 29th 1916.

The municipal council of Ross, pursuant to adjournment, met in the Town Hall, Forester's Falls, on Saturday, the 29th day of July 1916.

Present were Reeve Kirk and Councillors Ireton, Jamieson, McEwen and Rathwell.

Communications and bills were presented and considered.

Mr. McEwen introduced By-Law No. 339, of which he had given notice at last meeting of Council, and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Jamieson, was read a first time.

Mr. Rathwell introduced By-Law No. 340, of which he had given notice at last meeting of Council, and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Ireton, it was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Ireton, seconded by Mr. Rathwell, By-Law No. 331 was then read a third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. Rathwell, the Council adjourned for one hour.

On resuming work, Mr. Rathwell moved and Mr. Jamieson seconded that Mr. Wm Payne be given the privilege of removing the fence opposite the least end of lot No. 21, in concession 7, and of having and using a lane across the concession between lots one in the 7th and 8th concessions until such times as the said concession line is required.
