

Forester's Falls, Town Hall, Oct 7th 1916.

A special meeting of Ross Township Council was held here to-day, to consider the urgent British Red Cross appeal made under the auspices of the Organization of Resources Committee.

In this appeal every municipality is asked to take part on Oct. 19th by His Honour Sir John S. Hendrie, Lieutenant-Governour of Ontario, who is also Chairman of the Organization of Resources Committee. The slogan of the British Red Cross Society and the Order of St John is to carry voluntary aid to the sick and wounded of the British forces on land and sea in every region of the war. The meeting was also called for general business.

Councillors John Ireton, John Jamieson, Duncan McEwen, and Andrew Rathwell were present, with Reeve Kirk in the chair.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Ireton, it was resolved that this Council make a grant of six hundred dollars as a contribution from the Township of Ross to the British Red Cross Society and the Order of St John, and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign an order drawn on the treasurer for payment of same.

On motion of Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Jamieson, the bill of \$66.37 presented by Commissioner Rathwell for improvement

improvement of Highway on town line between Ross & Horton was accepted and an order drawn on treasurer for payment thereof.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Mr. McEwen, that Mr. Peter Wilson be instructed to have repaired the cattle pass on road opposite his farm.

Moved by Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Jamieson, That Council do now adjourn.
