

Forester's Falls, Town Hall, Oct. 28th. 1916.

A regular meeting of Ross Council was held here to-day, all the members were present, with the Reeve in the chair.

A number of communications, bills and accounts were presented and considered.

Among the communications was one from B J Roberts assistant secretary of the Organization of Resources Committee. The body of the letter is as follows: "Kindly accept our thanks for your letter of the 23rd inst advising us that your council has voted \$600 to the British Red Cross. Will you kindly express to your Council and to your citizens generally the appreciation of His Honour the Lieutenant-Governour, Chairman, and the other members of the Committee of your prompt response to the appeal of the British Red Cross."

Mr Ireton gave notice that he would at this meeting of council introduce a by-law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow the sum of \$400 to meet current expenses.

Mr. Ireton then introduced "By-law No. 343" of which he had given notice, and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Jamieson, it was read a first time.

After one hour's adjournment the council resumed work.
